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He holds a PhD from the Centre for Health Economics at the University of York, UK, and a MSc (Econ) from the London School of Economics & London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine.

Matthew leads WHO's strategic engagement on health financing policy with WHO Regional Offices in support of Member State's efforts to accelerate progress to UHC. He works on a range of health financing policy issues, including health financing policy in times of fiscal crisis, health financing in fragile and conflict-affected situations, as well as on broad health financing reforms, for example around the role of health insurance schemes.
