H.E. Heng Ratana has served as the Director General of the Cambodian Mine Action Centre (CMAC) since December 2008, holding the rank of Senior Minister in the Royal Government of Cambodia. He has over 30 years of experience in mine action and related fields, having played a pivotal role in strengthening CMAC's institutional capacity and expanding its international cooperation, particularly in Africa, Asia, and Latin America.

He began his career in the early 1990s with the United Nations and the Australian Government's Defence Cooperation Program before joining CMAC in 1997. Within CMAC, he has held senior positions including Deputy Director General (2001–2008), Chief of Cabinet (1999–2001), Head of Quality Assurance (1998–1999), and Programme Manager (1997–1998).

H.E. Heng Ratana holds an MBA from the University of Queensland, Australia. Internationally, he served as a member of the Advisory Board of the Geneva International Centre for Humanitarian Demining.
