Toru Homma serves as **Senior Advisor to the CEO of AUDA-NEPAD** since 2023, accelerating collaboration between AUDA-NEPAD and JICA through several programs such as Africa Kaizen Initiative, Home Grown Solutions Accelerator, AfCFTA and ASEAN cooperation. Mr. Homma also serves as **Senior Advisor on Private Sector Development of JICA** since 2010. He has led approximately 200 missions for the formulation, implementation and evaluation of development projects in the industry, investment and trade sector across Africa and Southeast Asia. As a recognized speaker, he has represented various international conferences, lectured in many training programs, and published articles, on a wide range of topics,

including industrial development, investment policy, trade promotion, industrial policy, smart manufacturing, innovation, SMEs, Kaizen, and sustainable development in Africa and ASEAN.

From 2006 to 2009, he also served the OECD as an investment policy analyst and project manager of the NEPAD-OECD Africa Investment Initiative at its headquarters in France. His career spans roles seconded from JICA to ministries in partner countries, including an investment promotion advisor in Myanmar, an SME development expert in Indonesia, and volunteer on energy project in Zambia, for 3 years each. He also served in JICA offices as a trade/investment advisor in Kenya and an investment/trade/industry advisor in Indonesia. Prior to these careers, he worked for a private construction company for business development for 4 years.

An engineer by profession, Mr. Homma holds a Master of Science in Industrial Strategy and Trade Policy from the University of Manchester. He has visited 125 countries including 32 African nations.
