Millogo Benoit

Millogo Benoit is a traditional musician from Burkina Faso, born into a Griot family. He mastered the talking drum (tama) in childhood and plays various West African instruments including djembe, balafon, and ngoni. Since 2009, he has been active between Japan and Burkina Faso. In 2021, he received the Himeji Cultural Award. As a member of BALANGOMA, he performs nationwide and also engages in instrument making, repairs, and workshops across genres.
